



Prerequisites

- Sprint Direct Connect* service from Sprint*
- Sprint Direct Connect license key from Telex Radio Dispatch (purchased option)
- IP-224 Ethernet adapter panel from Telex Radio Dispatch
- AdvanceBridge* and interface cable from AdvanceTec



Configuration

- Step 1. Activate Sprint Direct Connect Interface (purchased option) To activate the Sprint Direct Connect Interface, do the following:
 - 1. Open the IP-224 webpage.
 - 2. From the left navigation, select **Additional Features**. *The Additional Features page appears.*
 - 3. In the Access Key field, enter the **32-character option key**.
 - 4. Click the **Submit button**. *The Access Key is submitted.*
 - 5. From the left navigation, select **Save Parameters**.

The Save Parameters page appers.

6. Click the **Save Parameters button**. Changes are now permanently saved to the IP-224 console.

Quick Start Guide Sprint Direct Connect

Installation

To connect the IP-224 Ethernet adapter panel to the AdvanceBridge, do the following:

1. Connect the DB-37 end of the AdvanceBridge interface cable to RADIO 1 or RADIO 2 connector.



- 2. Verify the AdvanceBridge is **powered off**.
- 3. Connect the DB-15 end of the AdvanceBridge interface cable to the AdvanceBridge.



4. Plug the **power cable** to power on the AdvanceBridge.

The power LED is solid green when it connects to the IP-224.

5. Repeat **steps 1-4** to connect a second AdvanceBridge to the IP-224, if necessary.
