Your February 12, statement of conformance with TSO-C58 and Regulations of the Administrator, Part 514, are accepted for approval of your TEL-66T Hand-Held Dynamic Transistorized Microphone.

Accordingly, you are authorized to identify this equipment with the applicable TSO-C58 marking.

Regulations of the Administrator, Part 514, has been superseded, substantive change to Federal Aviation Regulation (FAR) 37, effective February 1, 1965.
